This year you will have your choice of giving to two local Catholic organizations that reach out to those so in need of the basic items that I know I take for granted.

Our own SCB parishioner, Sharon Brumer, has made me aware of an Advent gift ideas for their clients. Catholic Charities provides professional Human Services to persons of all faiths in our Archdiocese. In 2016 they served 44,000 persons in need. You will find cards on the Advent Tree that will give you a list of items to make up Bath Bundles, Dental Bundles, Hair Care Bundles, Laundry Bundles and Stationary Bundles that will be distributed by Catholic Charities to those in need.

You can also choose to donate much needed items to the Cathedral Center in downtown Milwaukee that ministers to homeless women and children. Therefore you will also find cards on the Advent Tree that identify items on the Cathedral's Wish list to include pajamas, slippers, and sweatshirts.

So, be on the lookout for the Advent Tree that will be displayed with the Christmas cards containing needed items on the First Sunday of Advent which is December 2nd and 3rd. The actual collection of gifts after all Masses will take place on the weekends of December 9th & 10th and December 16th & 17th.
