Registration

- If you have not handed in your **registration** information yet, please do so. I am currently using the the information to determine staffing and programing needs for the 2018-2019 school year. An accurate student count at the end of this month helps ensure that we will be able to provide the scholars with all the educational opportunities. Additional registration forms are available online or in the school office.
- **Before and After Care:** Scholars are not permitted to utilize their cell phones during before care. There is place to store the phones when the scholars enter. Before they go upstairs they can take their phones and check them into the school office.
- **Jump Rope for Heart:** ALL envelopes on event day February 27th All cash/check JRFH envelopes should brought to school next week Tuesday. All checks need to be made out to the American heart association as stated on the JRFH envelope.
 - In the Friday folders, there will be an "Out-of-uniform" day pass for students in grades 1st thru 8th for scholars that raised least 10 dollars and the parent must sign the sheet and return it. they can mark that their student has earned the pass on the JRFH envelope, they do not need to raise an additional 10 dollars as long as they have raised 10 they can earn the pass. This pass will go home in the Friday folders.
